Your Excellency,

The Lafna Kurd Humanitarian Organization (LKHO) was established in December 1988, during the genocidal ANFAL operation against the Kurdish people in northern Iraq. On behalf of the LKHO, I am writing to you to express the LKHO's full support of the recent allegations against the former Iraqi Chief of Staff, Mr. Nazar Al-Khazrajy.

In his positions as Head of the First Legion and as Chief of Staff of the Iraqi army, Mr. Al-Khazrajy has, undoubtedly, been involved in all the war crimes during the period 1986 to 1990, including the notorious ANFAL operation against the Kurdish people which was begun in February 1988. It is worth mentioning that all high-ranking army officers who had served the dictatorship's regime in Baghdad have been fleeing to western countries after having inflicted unspeakable crimes against the Kurdish people.

During this notorious regime's reign, over 182,000 Kurdish and 5,000 Barzany families disappeared. Over 4,000 villages have been pillaged, bulldozed or dynamited, leaving upward of 200,000 villagers and peasants homeless. Despite these heinous crimes against humanity, some Iraqi Arabs as well as an Iraqi Jural Assembly have defended Mr. Nazar Al-Khazrajy in the same way that they have supported the Baghdad regime.
